What are Playaways, you ask? Weighing about 2 ounces and no larger than a playing card, Playaways are prerecorded audio books that are perfect for the person on the go. Washing dishes, shoveling snow, weeding the garden are not exactly the most mentally stimulating chores. In fact, these chores, like most are as boring as heck. But pop a AAA battery in a Playaway, put in the earphones and listen to an audiobook and vacuuming floors gets a little less hateful when your brain is focused elsewhere.

Even better, Playaways may also be listened to in the car. Just plug in one end of an auxiliary cable into the car stereo and the other into the Playaway and you are good to go. Playaways are especially convenient for people driving newer model cars that no longer feature CD players.

Playaways may also be tailored to the listener. The device has five narration speeds, buttons to reverse or forward by chapter, as well as reverse or fast forward within a chapter. Playaways also have an LCD screen detailing book progress, battery life and current chapter being narrated.

Even better, the Calhoun Memorial Library has a variety of Playaways for both adults and children. So, take a minute on your next visit to the library and peruse the Playaways on display in the lobby. They are convenient, easy to operate and may be used in the home, car and outdoors.
